Item 6 - Election of Member Directors

The Articles of Association allow Volunteer Edinburgh to have a maximum number of 12 Board members, of which eight can be elected Member Directors, drawn from and elected by the membership of the organization. Up to four may be Appointed Directors. The board make appointments annually at the first meeting after the AGM, and may also do so during the year.

Volunteer Edinburgh currently has seven Member Directors, and three Appointed Directors.

Two of the Member Directors are required to retire by rotation at the AGM. Retirees are eligible for re-election, unless they have served the maximum six-year term as a Member Director.

This year John Lawrie and Edward Hibbert retire and stand for re-election.

Consequently there are three available spaces for Member Directors.

Una Phelan, who became an Appointed Director in 2019, is also standing for election as a Member Director.
